



What We Believe

1. The Godhead: Our God is one, but manifests in three people, namely the father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
2. The love, grace, and sovereignty of God in creating, sustaining, ruling, redeeming and judging the World.
3. The Scriptures: The Bible, made up of the Old and New Testaments is the inspired Word of God, the product of holy men of old who spoke and wrote, as the Holy Spirit over them – fully trustworthy for faith and conduct.
4. Man, is a created being, made in the likeness and image of God. Through Adam's transgression and fall, sin came into the world. The only means of being cleansed from sin is through faith in the redemptive work of Jesus Christ.
5. The Baptism by the Holy Spirit, according to Acts 2:4, is given to believers who ask for it. The Baptism in the Holy Spirit is a gift from God. This experience is

accomplished by the evidence of speaking in other tongues as the Holy Spirit gives Utterance.

6. The incarnation of God's eternal Son, the Lord Jesus Christ – born of the Virgin Mary; is truly divine and truly human, yet without sin.

7. The atoning sacrifice of Christ on the cross: dying in our place, paying the price of sin and defeating evil, so reconciling us with God.

8. The justification of sinners solely by the grace of God through faith in Christ.

9. In Water Baptism by immersion and a direct commandment of our Lord is for believers only.

10. The ministry of God's Holy Spirit, who leads us to repentance, unites us with Christ through new birth, empowers our discipleship and enables our witness.

11. In the doctrine of sanctification as a definite yet progressive work of grace.

12. In healing for the physical ills of the human body and is wrought by the power of God through the prayer of faith and by the laying on of hands.

13. A simple belief that power or anointing or any other necessary quality can be transmitted from one person to another through the laying on of hands.

14. The Church, the body of Christ both local and universal, the priesthood of all believers - given life by the Spirit and endowed with the Spirit's gifts to worship God and proclaim the gospel, promoting justice and love.

15. The personal and visible return of Jesus Christ to fulfil the purposes of God, who will raise all people to judgment, bring eternal life to the redeemed and eternal condemnation to the lost, and establish a new heaven and new earth.
